The purpose of our social media accounts is to inform the community about the Macon Judicial Circuit District Attorney's Office and our efforts to keep Middle Georgia families safe.

We encourage you to submit your questions, comments, and concerns, but please note these are moderated accounts. Accounts are generally monitored only during regular business hours. We strive to respond to direct messages and comments as quickly as possible.

Once posted, the Macon Judicial Circuit District Attorney's Office reserves the right to delete or hide comments that contain:

1. Vulgar language
2. Personal attacks
3. Content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, genetics, public assistance status, national origin, physical or intellectual disability, or sexual orientation
4. Spam or links to other sites
5. Off-topic content
6. Content advocating illegal activity
7. Content that promotes particular services, products, or political organizations
8. Content that infringes on copyrights or trademarks
9. Personally identifiable medical information
10. Information that may compromise criminal or civil investigations

Repeated violations will result in a user being banned from posting to the account where the violations have occurred.
